Tomorrow we open Virtual Haverford and the Middle School's Virtual Village. If you need to pick up any materials, Mrs. G. and I are in Virtue Village today until noon. You are welcome to swing by and practice appropriate social distancing.

Our teachers put in a lot of extra hours over the weekend, yesterday and today to provide a level of instruction and continuity of learning that is new for all of us. Therefore, we share today a proposed schedule for tomorrow and Thursday as well as a list of ideas that will help your son as well as our teachers in the delivery of content and the support of the boys.

## 1. Virtual Village Schedule

- Our Virtual Village will have a daily check-in, a virtual homeroom, with your son's advisor before moving to virtual classes. Classes follow the assigned schedule below for each of the boy's grade level sections. We understand in the real world, our boys may not be available at all times. Therefore, instruction will be through any number of modalities to include live video, recorded video, worksheets, podcasts, and more. We anticipate a majority of our students who are able to follow the morning schedule will complete most of their work by lunch. Below is a detailed schedule. Please encourage your son to look over the schedule and compare it to his schedule on MyBackpack to help him to better understand how it will flow as it may require him to move from one section to another. Classes listed in red is where most shifting will occur. Advisors will help to cover the schedule every morning in Homeroom.

Time for the completion of homework, student support, and individual questions would run from 1:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. Boys and parents who have additional questions can schedule meetings during this time period. **Teachers will respond to email as quickly as possible and within 24 hours.** From 2:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. we expect our boys to complete their homework or participate in the PE challenge of the day.

Besides our work and helping our Haverford School families, we also have our own families to worry about, especially children and older

parents. Please communicate all your concerns with the folks in our division and we will do what we can to assist as we all navigate these historic circumstances. Remember, we are all in this together. Patience, flexibility, and communication will help us all through this process. If you would like an individual phone call, meeting or conference, please make an appointment with me, your son's advisor or teacher.
