

## Summer Reading for Rising Sixth Graders at The Haverford School 2020-21

All students are required to read, The Ranger's Apprentice Book 1:

The Ruins of Gorlan, by John Flanagan for English 6

AND Flush, by Carl Hiaasen for Science 6.

In addition, students should read two other books of

their choice over the summer.

After reading each of the four books, the students should write a typed or handwritten paragraph. In the paragraph, give the following information:

- Student name, first and last.
- Author and title of the book.
- Short description of the book.
- Favorite part or favorite character, and why
- Whether or not you would recommend it to a classmate, and why
