



Boys entering Kindergarten: Mathematics

Counting	Count by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s past 100 and back by 1s from any number less than 100 (with and without number grids, number lines, and calculators)
Comparing and ordering numbers	Compare and order whole numbers up to 1,000.
Math Facts	Demonstrate appropriate fluency with addition and subtraction facts through 10+10.
Addition and subtraction procedures	Using a variety of methods, solve problems involving the addition and subtraction of 1-digit whole numbers with 2-digit whole numbers
Money	Know and compare the value of pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters, and dollar bills; make exchanges between coins.
