DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY

Student use or possession of illegal drugs and alcohol and the misuse of prescription drugs has no place in our community and is forbidden.

- Students or families who seek out help <u>prior</u> to a violation of the Drug and Alcohol Policy will be given support <u>without any disciplinary action</u>.
- The <u>sale or distribution</u> of alcohol or illegal or prescription drugs will result in <u>expulsion with no possibility of readmission</u>, and law enforcement will be notified.
- Possession of alcohol or illegal drugs or drugs prescribed for others will result in dismissal with the possibility of readmission the following school year.
- <u>Use</u> of alcohol or illegal drugs will result in disciplinary action, to include <u>suspension</u>, and the student will be required to meet with the School Counselor who will coordinate a drug and alcohol evaluation.
- Evidence of <u>use</u> for a <u>second</u> time will result in dismissal.
